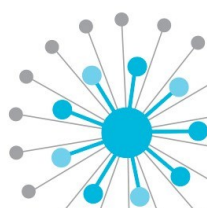
## Biography

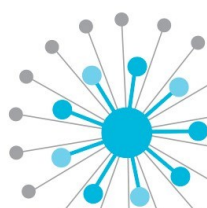
